Abstract:

Easy earnings, risk, are attributes that we would usually refer to the game, especially gambling. On closer inspection, however, these terms could be used to describe part of a world that is apparently distant from it: the world of the financial markets. This is the case of trading online, i.e. the marketing of financial instruments through technological platforms. To attract the sale of these products, in fact, are often used deceptive commercial practices, especially if aimed at an inexperienced investor. When the boundaries between the two worlds narrow, the jurist is called to redefine their contours. In the European panorama, the task of supervising and guaranteeing the protection of traders and the regularity of the market lies with the National Competent Authorities and, alternatively, European Supervisory Authorities - given the growing cross-border dimension of the phenomenon.
